# ELIGIBILITY

Environmental Sanitation Science	: Pass marks in B.Sc., Chemistry
Course	and B.Sc., Food Technology
Certificate course on Capacity building	: Pass in any subject with 10 +2 HSC.

# SUBMITTING FILLED-IN APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

- 1) Applicants are requested to read carefully the rules of eligibility and other instructions given in the prospectus.
  - The entries in the application form should be made by the applicant in their own hand writing legibly in ENGLISH only.
  - Details of the xerox copies of the certificate submitted along with the application should be mentioned in the application.

#### 2) Enclosures to be sent along with the filled-in application.

Original certificates should not be sent. The candidates have to submit xerox copies of the following certificates duly attested by a Gazetted Officer along with the application form.

- a. SSLC, HSE mark statement
- b. U.G./P.G degree Marks statement / Grade certificates/ Provisional certificates
- c. Community certificate obtained from Tahsildar/Deputy Tahsildar concerned.
- d. Two self addressed, stamped envelopes (27 X 11 CM), each for Rs.10/- should be enclosed.
- e. Filling with any wrong information or suppression of information may result in punitive action.
- f. Certificates other than those required need not be enclosed
- g. The application form without the xerox copies of relevant certificates will not be considered.
- h. All the columns in the application should be filled-in. incomplete application will be rejected.

### 3) Photograph

Two recent passport size colour photographs of the candidate are required. One should be affixed in the application form and one additional to be sent along with the application.

### SELECTION PROCEDURE AND COMMUNICATION

The applications received will be screened and selection will be up to a maximum of 40 students for Environmental Sanitation Science course and 60 students for Health workers Course. The selected candidates will be communicated about the admission individually by post or by email address, if given. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on the website.

### FEES DETAILS

The fees can be paid in two installments. At time of admission, the first installment should be paid and within three months the second installment should be paid in case of both courses. A caution deposit of Rs.2,000/- is payable by each student, which will be refunded after completion of the course.
