


ADULTS SHEET : PERSONAL DETAILS, EDUCATION & WORK (FOR THOSE ABOVE 16 YEARS OF AGE)

MEASURING HEIGHT: ♦ Please make the female volunteer conduct this test for women or request another village lady/girl to do this. ♦ Make the person stand upright against a wall (after removing footwear) and mark the wall using a ruler and pencil. Ask the person to move away from the wall, and measure the height from the floor to the marked spot on the wall using an inch tape. ♦ Mark in cms.

MEASURING WEIGHT: ♦ Pass your hand firmly across the window of the weighing machine. Wait for it to show 0.0. ♦ Then request the person to stand on top of the machine. Wait for a few seconds. Then note the weight shown below to the nearest first decimal. ♦ If the weighing machine shows “Err”, then request the person to get off the scale, wait for a few seconds until 0.0 shows again. ♦ Remember that it takes a few seconds after the lady stands on the scale for the weight to show. ♦ If a person refuses to have her weight taken, then mark ‘Could Not Weigh’.

Salt test instructions:

- ♦ Take a small sample of household cooking salt.
- ♦ Squeeze a drop of the white bottle solution. If it turns blue, mark as iodized.
- ♦ In case, salt does not turn blue, do a re-check test. Squeeze a drop of the RED bottle solution and on top of that a drop of white bottle solution. If the salt turns blue, mark salt is iodized.
- ♦ If still salt does not turn blue, mark as not iodized.
